

FERNS

Great hardy ferns for your shady areas. Ferns add texture and color for a lush woodland garden!



Maidenhair Fern (*Adiantum pedatum aleuticum*)

Native, very airy with wiry black stems. Great in containers. ~2 feet.

East Indian Holly Fern (*Arachnioides simplicior* 'Variegata')

Semi-evergreen, yellow stripes run length of fronds. ~15 inches



Hart's Tongue Fern (*Asplenium scolopendrium*)

Evergreen, unique, broad strap like fronds. ~15 inches

Tatting Fern (*Athyrium filix-femina* 'Frizelliae')

Unique bright green "beaded" looking fronds. ~10 inches



Japanese Painted Fern (*Athyrium nipponicum pictum*)

Colorful silvery white fronds with purple highlights. ~15 inches

Deer Fern (*Blechnum spicant*)

Evergreen, native, with erect fertile and prostrate sterile fronds. ~20 inches.



Autumn Fern (*Dryopteris erythrosora*)

Super colorful new fronds of copper, orange, red, yellow. ~2 feet

Ostrich Fern (*Matteuccia struthiopteris*)

Taller, vase shaped fern, spreads to form colonies. ~5 feet

Royal Fern (*Osmunda regalis*)

Distinct larger frond segments, will take wet soil. ~5 feet



Sword Fern (*Polystichum munitum*)

Evergreen, native, very adaptable tough fern. ~2-4 feet

Tassel Fern (*Polystichum polyblepharum*)

Evergreen, dense dark green fronds. ~30 inches



Soft Shield Fern, Alaska Fern (*Polystichum setiferum*)

Evergreen, with soft, lacy fronds. ~30 inches
