

VINES

A selection of vines for sun and shade

Akebia (*Akebia quinata*)

Fragrant purple or white flowers, fast, semi-evergreen, likes shade, morning sun ok.

Trumpet Vine (*Campsis*)

Yellow/orange/red tubular flowers, very fast, deciduous, needs sun and a hot spot to flower well, attracts hummingbirds

Clematis

Large range of colors and bloom time, deciduous, sun or partial shade

Evergreen Clematis (*Clematis armandii*)

Fragrant white flower in early spring, evergreen, likes shade, morning sun ok, very fast

Climbing Hydrangea (*Hydrangea anomala petiolaris*)

Heart shaped leaves, loose clusters of white flowers, slow grower, likes shade, morning sun ok, deciduous, attaches by aerial roots

Evergreen Climbing Hydrangea (*Hydrangea seemanii* & *integrifolia*)

Glossy evergreen leaves, white flower clusters, slow, likes shade

Honeysuckle (*Lonicera*)

Tubular flowers, many varieties, some very fragrant, fast grower, semi evergreen. Sun or partial shade. 'Halliana' very fragrant white/yellow flowers, 'Goldlame' fragrant pink/yellow flowers 'Purpurea' fragrant purple/white

Virginia Creeper & Boston Ivy (*Parthenocissus quinquefolia* & *tricuspidata*)

Both with fabulous orange and red fall color, fast, deciduous, sun or partial shade

Passionflower (*Passiflora cearulea* 'Blue Crown')

Unique blue and white flowers all summer, tender vine for protected site, deciduous, fast grower in full sun

Ornamental Grape (*Vitis vinifera* 'Purpurea')

Green leaves turn deep purple in fall, can produce tiny cluster of fruit, fast grower in full sun

Wisteria (*Wisteria floribunda* & *sinensis*)

Vigorous vines with long racemes of fragrant white/pink/purple/blue flowers, full sun, need a sturdy support and regular pruning
