Cascade Gold	Summerbearing Florican	Large	Firm fruit with tart, juicy, sweet flavor	June-July	Fresh, preserves, freezing 
Itsaul Summer	Everbearing Primocane	Medium	Delicious, sweet fruit	May-November	Fresh, preserves, freezing 
Latham	Summerbearing Florican 	Medium	Firm fruit with sweet flavor	June-July	Fresh, preserves, freezing 
Munger Black	Summerbearing Florican 	Large	Plump, firm fruit with sweet flavor, not seedy.	July	Fresh, preserves, cooking 
Meeker	Summerbearing Florican 	Large	Firm fruit with sweet flavor	June-July	Fresh, preserves, cooking 
Raspberry Shortcake	Summerbearing Florican 	Medium	Dwarf, thornless raspberry with sweet fruit	July	Fresh, preserves, freezing, cooking 

Summerbearing (Florican)-Bear fruit on two year old canes in early summer. Everbearing (Primocane)-Bear fruit on one year old canes in late summer, and on 2 year old canes in early summer.

Pixwell 	Gooseberry	Pinkish green	Medium sized; Superb flavor	Fast growing Upright shrub	Delicious for fresh eating or for pies and jellies. 
Poorman 	Gooseberry	Pinky red	Very sweet; disease resistant	Upright small shrub	Pies, jams, fresh

 Boysenberry	Blackberry x Raspberry x Loganberry Cross	Large dark maroon	Soft, juicy, sweet/tart raspberry like flavor	Trailing; bears fruit on two year old canes	Fresh, juice, desserts, preserves, freezing 
 Columbia Star	Blackberry x Boysenberry Cross	Large black	Firm, sweet fruit, thornless	Trailing; bears fruit on two year old canes	Fresh, juice, desserts, freezing 
 Loganberry	Blackberry x Red Raspberry Cross	Med, long, red	Soft, unique tartness, highly flavored	Trailing; bears fruit on two year old canes	Preserves, wines & juice, pies 
 Marionberry	Blackberry	Large shiny black	Firm, sweet, with mild wild blackberry flavor	Trailing; bears fruit on two year old canes	Fresh, preserves, freezing, desserts 
 Polar Berry	Blackberry	Large white creamy	Sweet, juicy, nice flavor, unique color	Upright; 36-48" tall Great in containers	Preserves, fresh, juice 
 Tayberry	Loganberry x Black Raspberry Cross	Large reddish purple	Strong, slightly tart, juicy	Trailing; bears fruit on two year old canes	Preserves, pies, wine 

# Currants

Variety	Type	Berry	Flavor	Size	Uses
Cherry Red	Red 	Self fertile	Tart, acid flavor	4 to 6 feet	 Jams, jellies, sauces
Consort	Black 	Self fertile	Very strong, sweet musky flavor	4 to 6 feet	 Jams & jellies, juice & wine, dried
Crandall	Black 	Self fertile	Sweet tart, More mild	3 to 4 feet	 Jams & jellies, syrups & juice
Primus	White 	Self fertile	Sweet, long clusters	3 to 4 feet	 Jams & jellies, syrups & juice
Red Lake	Red 	Self Fertile	Large dark clusters	4 to 6 feet	 Jellies, preserves & muffins
