	Karmijn de Sonnaville <i>Cox x Jonathon</i>	Mid/ Late	Late Sept/ October	Scab Susceptible	Medium to large; red over yellow/green; sweet/tart blend, aromatic	Stores very well; flavor improves in storage. Great for fresh, cooking, and cider or juice	This apple requires a pollinator, and will not pollinate other apple trees. Try another mid to late season bloomer. Do not use Gravenstein or King.
	King <i>Aka King of Tompkins County</i>	Mid/ Late	Early/ Mid October	Scab Susceptible	Very large red striped fruit; firm, crisp & juicy, sweet	Another old-timer; good all-purpose apple and stores well. Good dessert, cooking or cider apple	This apple requires a pollinator, and will not pollinate other apple trees. Try Honeycrisp, Spartan or any mid season bloomer. Do not use Gravenstein or Karmijn de Sonnaville
	Liberty <i>Macoun x Purdue</i>	Early/ Mid	Early October	Scab Immune	Medium size red fruit; crisp & juicy, tart	Heavy fruit set results in small apples, so plan on doing some thinning. Stores well. 	Summerred <i>McIntosh x Golden Delicious</i>	Mid	August/ Sept	Scab Susceptible	Medium dark red fruit, juicy mellow flavor, sweet	Great fresh eating & for cooking. Thin fruit and prune regularly for best fruit set. Developed in B.C.	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Gravenstein Karmijn de Sonnaville or King
