- JEFFERSON:** Immune to Eastern Filbert Blight.
Medium sized nut with well filled shells; good yields.
Pollinate with Theta, Yamhill or York.
- SACAJAWEA:** Resistant to Eastern Filbert Blight.
Large nuts with great flavor, good yields with few blanks.
Nuts mature in August/September
Pollinate with Jefferson, Theta, Yamhill or York.
- THETA:** Immune to Eastern Filbert Blight.
Flavorful, medium size nuts.
Pollinate with Jefferson, Sacajawea, Yamhill or York.
- YAMHILL:** Immune to Eastern Filbert Blight. Smaller, more compact tree.
Small to medium size nuts, quite productive.
Very good texture and flavor.
Pollinate with Jefferson, Sacajawea, Theta or York.

WALNUTS

English

- CARPATHIAN:** Plump, thin shelled walnut.
Slightly smaller but much hardier. Full flavor, excellent quality.
Fast growing symmetrical tree with a spreading crown.
Bears in 5 to 7 years. Pest and disease resistant.
Likes sunny, deep, fertile, well-drained soil. Avoid planting in frost pockets.
Nuts fall free of husks when ripe in late fall.
Pollinate with Manregion or Cascade
- CASCADE:** Large walnut with excellent flavor.
Productive tree bears heavily. Very cold hardy.
Originated in Washington. Rated #1 by North American Nut Growers Association.
Pollinate with Carpathian or Manregion.
- MANREGION:** Good size, round, soft shelled nut. Mild flavor.
Tends to produce large yields of good quality nuts. Quantity may vary.
Quite vigorous growing. Very hardy.
Pollinate with Carpathian or Cascade.
