











PEAR VARIETIES 2020

Variety	Approx. Harvest	Scab	Fruit & Flavor	Cold Storage	Pollination
 Anjou	Late Sept/ Early October	Scab Susceptible	Green pear; Juicy, aromatic, mild sweet spicy flavor with fine flesh. Good all purpose pear, fresh and cooking.	Store 4 to 6 weeks Ripen at room temperature Keeps until spring	Pollinate with any other European Pear on this list
 Bartlett	September	Scab Susceptible	Large, smooth green-yellow pear with soft, sweet, aromatic flesh. Great for canning.	Keeps about 4 to 6 weeks	Pollinate with any other European Pear on this list
 Bosc	Late Sept/ Oct	Scab Susceptible	Cinnamon brown with russeting over skin, honey sweetness, juicy. Good for fresh eating, baking, broiling and poaching.	Up to 4 months.	Self-fertile
 Highland	Sept/ October	Scab Susceptible	Large, smooth, greenish-yellow with some russeting. Juicy, smooth texture; rich sweet flavor.	About 1 month of storage. Enjoy all winter long.	Pollinate with any other European pear on this list.
 Orcas	Late August/ Early September	Scab Resistant	Large red blushed pear; Sweet, mild flavor. Good all purpose pear, discovered on Orcas Island and perfect for growing in the PNW.	Keeps about 4 to 6 weeks	Pollinate with any other European pear on this list
 Ubileen	August	Scab Resistant	Large greenish fruit with red blush. Juicy sweet, fine texture, aromatic. Vigorous and productive tree, one of the first pears to ripen.	Keeps about 4 to 6 weeks	Pollinate with any other European pear on this list

	<p>Chojuro</p> <p>Mid September</p>	<p>Scab Resistant</p>	<p>Flattened, medium size brown russeted fruit. Crisp juicy white flesh, mild and slightly aromatic. Keeps all winter, eat fresh off tree. Thin fruits in early summer for best fruit production.</p>	<p>Pollinate with any other Asian Pear on this list</p>
	<p>Hosui</p> <p>September</p>	<p>Scab Resistant</p>	<p>Medium to large, rounded, brownish yellow fruit. Juicy, sweet/tart, crisp, fine textured. Stores thru December.</p>	<p>Pollinate with any other Asian Pear on this list</p>
	<p>Kousi</p> <p>Early August</p>	<p>Scab Resistant</p>	<p>Small to medium yellow fruit with bronze russeting. Sweet taste, crisp and juicy. Stores thru September. Thin fruits for best fruit production.</p>	<p>Pollinate with any other Asian Pear on this list</p>
	<p>Nijesseiki</p> <p>Mid September</p>	<p>Scab Resistant</p>	<p>Rounded, green-yellow pear with mild, sweet/tart flavor. Firm and juicy white flesh. Thin for best fruit production. Also known as '20th Century Pear'.</p>	<p>Pollinate with any other Asian Pear on this list.</p>
