







Variety	Bloom Time	Approx. Ripening	Scab Resistance	Fruit & Flavor	Tips	Pollination
 Akane Jonathon x Worcester Permain	Mid/ Late	Early/Mid Sept	Scab Resistant	Round, bright red fruit; Firm, crisp & juicy; excel- lent sweet/sharp flavor	Great for fresh eating! Early season apple doesn't store well but holds well on the tree. AKA Tokyo Rose.	Pollinate with any other apple on this list. EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
 Beni Shogun Fuji Sport of Fuji	Mid	Late Sept/ October	Moderate Scab Resistance	Bright red; crisp, juicy, very sweet Japanese apple, decent keeper	Fresh, sauce & cooking apple. This type of Fuji has the best chance of ripening in our area	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
 Bramley	Late	October	Scab Resistant	Large green apple with specks of red. Firm, crisp, juicy & acidic.	English variety considered to be one of the best cooking apples due to it's high acidic content. Use for cider, baking.	Pollinate with any other mid to late apple on the list EXCEPT Jonagold. & Gravenstein Will not pollinate other apples!
 Chehalis Golden Delicious Seedling	Mid	Mid/Late Sept	Scab Resistant	Greenish-yellow, large fruit; tart, juicy, crisp, slightly acidic	Fresh eating if you wait till it's sweet enough, good for baking and cider	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
 Cortland McIntosh x Ben Davis	Mid	Mid Sept/ Oct	Scab Susceptible	Dark red, white flesh re- sists browning; tart, tangy, juicy	McIntosh type apple great for fresh eating and pretty much everything else!	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
 Cosmic Crisp® Enterprise x Honeycrisp	Mid/ Late	Late Sept/ Early Oct	Scab Resistant	Large, bright red, juicy, sweet, sharp, firm	Excellent for fresh eating & cooking. High sugar content. Stores well. Flesh does not brown easily. Only plant in WA state. From WSU.	Pollinate with any other mid to late apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
 Empire Red Delicious X McIntosh	Early/ Mid	Sept/Oct	Scab Susceptible	Maroon-red fruit with lighter green. Sweet and crunchy.	Great for fresh eating, sauce, baking, pies	Pollinate with any other mid to late apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
 Enterprise Golden Delicious, McIntosh, Rome Beauty	Mid/ Late	Late October	Scab Immune	Bright glossy, red & yellow fruit; rich, spritely flavor mellows w/age	Good for fresh eating and cooking, great disease resistance, stores well	Pollinate with any other mid to late apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold

 Golden Sentinel	Mid	Early October	Scab Susceptible	Large, golden yellow; sweet & juicy	Great columnar apple for gardeners with limited space or for patio/container gardens	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
 Gravenstein	Early	Early September	Scab Susceptible	Large, yellow with red Stripes; aromatic, crisp, juicy and tangy	Old favorite, excellent for cooking/baking. Tends to bear alternate years. Keeps about 3 weeks in cold storage.	Requires pollinator, use another early/mid season apple EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold Will not pollinate other apples!
 Honeycrisp <small>Keepsake</small>	Mid/Late	Mid October	Scab Resistant	Medium sized, mottled red over yellow fruit; very crisp, sweet & juicy	Excellent for fresh eating, also cooking, stores well	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
 Jonagold <small>Golden Delicious x Jonathan</small>	Mid	Mid October	Scab Susceptible	Large blushed red fruit, firm, juicy, slightly tart; superb flavor when ripe	Excellent for fresh eating, also cooking, does not store well.	This apple requires a pollinator, Try any mid-season bloomer EXCEPT Bramley & Gravenstein Will not pollinate other apples!
 Lodi <small>Montgomery x Yellow Transparent</small>	Mid	August	Scab Susceptible	Large yellow fruit; good sharp, tangy flavor.	One of the first apples to ripen; best for cooking, juice, sauces.	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
 Maslin <small>Aka Early Pink Lady</small>	Early	Early September	Scab Susceptible	Large crisp, sweet tart apple.	Great for fresh eating. Late ripening, but matures 3-4 weeks earlier	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
 Northpole	Mid	Late Sept	Scab Susceptible	Medium to large bright red fruit; crisp & juicy	Great columnar apple for gardeners with limited space or for patio/container gardens	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
 Pristine <small>Mcintosh, Gold Delicious, Rome</small>	Mid/Late	July/August	Scab Immune	Lemon yellow fruit; mild tart flavor, crisp & tasty	Early ripening productive tree, stores well, good fresh, for baking or sauce	Pollinate with any other mid to late bloom apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
 Scarlet Sentinel	Mid	Late Sept	Scab Susceptible	Green with red blush fruit; crisp & sweet.	Great columnar apple for patio/container gardens; most dwarf of the columnar types	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold

	Snow Fameuse	Mid/Late	October	Scab Susceptible	Small size dark red to red striped fruit; spicy aromatic snow white flesh	Antique apple; parent of McIntosh; great for dessert, cooking, cider; keeps thru December; hardy long lived tree	Pollinate with any other mid to late bloom apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
	Spartan McIntosh x Newton Pippin	Mid/Late	October	Scab Resistant	Small size dark red fruit; crisp juicy, firm w/fine sweet flavor	McIntosh type, great fresh, more firm, stores well. Heavy producer so thinning fruit is a good idea	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
	Spitzenburg Aka Esopus Spitzenburg	Mid/Late	October	Scab Susceptible	Medium to large; red-orange blush, yellowish flesh	Old timer; complex flavor considered very tasty and balanced. Tends to bear biennially	Pollinate with any other mid to late bloom apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
	Sunrise Magic® Gala x Splendour	Mid	October	Scab Susceptible	Medium to large size orange-red fruit; excellent flavor, crisp, juicy	From WSU; highly rated in taste tests; stores very well; aka Only plant in WA state.	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
	Whitney Crabapple	Mid	July to August	Scab Resistant	Round red, golf ball size fruit; sweet, juicy yellow flesh.	Heavy bearer, great for canning, preserves, pickling. Self fertile and a good pollinator for apple trees.	Self-fertile, no pollinator required.
	William's Pride Jonathan X Rome Beauty	Early/Mid	August	Scab Resistant	Medium sized, mottled red over yellow fruit; very crisp, sweet & juicy	Excellent for fresh eating, also stores well	Pollinate with any other apple on this list EXCEPT Bramley, Gravenstein, Jonagold
