Variety	Ripening Season	Berry Size	Flavor	Fall Color	Height	Description
Aurora	Very Late	Medium	Tart, but will get sweeter if allowed to ripen.	Dark red	5 to 6 Feet	Latest ripening blueberry in PNW. Berries ripen over 3-4 pickings and develop better flavor if allowed to ripen..
Blue Ray	Mid	Large	Flavorful, sweet	Red	5 to 7 feet	Productive plant with tight berry clusters. Excellent quality, reliable old-time berry.
Bluecrop	Mid	Large	Classic blueberry, sweet and spicy	Red	4 to 6 feet	Open, medium to large berry clusters. Tart if picked early, spicy when fully ripe. Good all around use berry. Bears for over one month.
Bluegold	Mid	Large	Flavorful, sweet	Yellow	4 to 5 feet	Large, easy to pick clusters of sky blue fruit. Compact shrub with great golden yellow canes and fall color.
Bonus	Mid to Late	Very Large	Sweet & extra juicy	Orange & red	5-6' feet	Self-fertile; narrow upright shrub with very large bright blue berries.
Bountiful Blue	Mid	Med	Sweet & juicy	Semi-ever-green	3 to 4 feet	Self-fertile; good choice for containers; compact, rounded habit, pretty fall highlights.
Chandler	Mid to late	Very Very Large	Full, excellent blueberry flavor	Red	5 to 7 feet	Largest berries with excellent flavor. Ripens over a long period. Developed by the USDA and tested in Oregon.
Darrow	Late	Large	Sweet-tart robust flavor	Red	5 to 7 feet	Firm fruit, tart until completely ripe, then has excellent flavor. Loose fruit cluster. Consistently productive, great for PNW. Mummyberry resistant.
Draper	Mid	Large	Crisp & sweet	Yellow	3 to 4 Feet	Smaller size bush, very productive, with easy to pick berries.
Duke	Early	Large	Firm, crisp, sweet fruit	Yellow	4 to 6 feet	Medium to large size, firm, crisp, light blue berries of good quality. Large, easy to pick clusters with snappy flavor. Mummyberry resistant.

Earliblue	Very Early	Med Large	Full flavored, sweet and juicy	Red	4 to 6 feet	Long, open, loose clusters of firm, light blue berries. Excellent full flavor, mild and sweet. Red canes and red fall color, makes a good landscape plant.
Elliott	Very Late	Med	Quite tart with strong blueberry flavor	Yellow	4 to 5 feet	Heavy producer, slower growing bush. One of the latest ripening to extend the berry picking season. Red canes.
Legacy	Mid/Late	Med	Sweet, flavorful, aromatic	Red	4 to 6 feet	High flavor rating in USDA trials. Vigorous & productive, May keep its leaves thru winter, with fall color highlights.
Liberty	Late	Med	Sweet, flavorful	Red & Orange	7 to 8 feet	Firm berries are easy to pick. Vigorous grower with high yields. Performs well in the PNW.
Nelson	Late	Large	Excellent	Yellow Red	6 feet	High yield plant with consistent crops; vigorous grower.
Northblue	Mid	Med	Firm, sweet & juicy	Red	2 to 3 Feet	Self-pollinating. Same exceptional flavor of a wild blueberry. Very hardy in the PNW, half-high.
Northland	Mid	Med	Sweet, mild flavor	Yellow	4 to 5 feet	Extremely productive, high yields. High sugar content; great in jams and for baking. Easy to grow and adaptable.
Olympia	Mid	Large	Superb sweet flavor and aroma.	Red	5 feet	Large dark blue berries, vigorous and highly productive plant. Excellent for freezing and eating fresh..
Patriot	Early	Large	Firm, good sweet flavor	Red to Orange	4 to 6 feet	Large to very large dark blue fruit. Consistent, heavy producer, vigorous plant with fiery orange to red fall color. Best variety in wetter soils.
Pink Lemonade	Mid to Late	Med	Sweet, clean flavor with good texture.	Yellow To Orange	5 to 7 feet	It's pink! Firm, mild flavored berries Mature to deep pink. Moderate yields, Vigorous grower.
Razz	Mid	Med To Large	Sweet with raspberry undertones	Red To Orange	5 to 6 Feet	Plump, powdery blue berries ripen very quickly, pick as they ripen for most intense flavor. Good for fresh eating.
Reka	Early	Med	Firm, rich & tangy	Burgundy red	4 to 6 feet	Adapts to many soil types and climates. High yielding.

Spartan	Early	Very Large	Tops in flavor, robust firm fruit	Yellow	4 to 6 feet	Very large, firm, bright blue berries. Superb for eating fresh or in pies. Heavy producer, great variety. Easy to pick. Resistant to mummy berry.
Sunshine Blue	Mid to Late	Med	Rich, sweet flavor	Semi-ever-green	3 to 4 feet	Self-fertile. Abundant crops. Great choice for containers. Nice ornamental plant with pretty pink blooms.
Sweet-heart	Early	Large	Firm, sweet & juicy berries.	Red	5 to 6 feet	Self pollinating. Produces heavy crops early in the season and sometimes has a lighter second crop in late August.
Toro	Early to Mid	Large	Mildly sweet, firm, very good flavor	Red	4 to 6 feet	Very large berries in tight clusters. Very good flavor; extremely productive variety. Nice ornamental value as well. Easy to pick.
